




Georgia Military College Transfer Agreement Pathway to South College BSN Program


South College (SC) and Georgia Military College (GMC) hereby enter into a partnership that promotes student transfer. The partnership provides a transfer pathway to facilitate the transfer of associate degree course credit to be applied toward SC Atlanta's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program requirements upon college acceptance and program application and acceptance.

The intent of the agreement is to encourage GMC students to complete pre-requisite course requirements for the SC BSN program at GMC prior to submitting application to the SC Atlanta campus BSN program. Please refer to the Appendix to view the specific transfer pathway. GMC credits identified as acceptable through this pathway will be accepted for transfer without evaluation on a course-by-course basis. Transfer of credit does not guarantee admission to SC or any SC program. All other academic and program requirements of the major degree and college (such as the college admission requirements, grade point average, technical standards, interviews, drug/background screenings, observation hours, additional courses, etc.) must be satisfied. Students in any articulated program will not be expected to meet any additional (or fewer) requirements than non-transfer South College students.

1. GMC will indicate completed courses on the student's transcript. SC will, when evaluating the student's transcript, honor the terms of the agreement for admission to SC.
2. Prior to associate degree completion, GMC students should have access to advising from Georgia Military College and/or South College staff on the study leading to completion of the degree they are seeking at South College. During this period, students should also have access to advising by SC staff regarding requirements of the program of study at SC.
3. Students must meet all other graduation requirements of SC including the general, major, and professional education requirements. This includes minimum credit hours, institutional/departmental grade and grade point average requirements, and upper division credit and grade point average requirements, as stipulated in the SC Catalog.
4. For participating students, the transfer agreement is effective for six years from the original entry into college level work at GMC. If more than six years elapse from the student's initial date of participation under the agreement, the transfer agreement in place at the time of transfer to SC will determine the student's progress toward degree completion.

Appendix – Transfer Pathway

Courses identified are required for application to the South College Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program. Students completing these courses will meet the pre-requisite course requirements* for the South College BSN program as stipulated.

The following proposal is designed to provide a pathway by which graduates of the Georgia Military College Pre-Nursing (AA, AS) can transfer associate degree course credits to South College.
