Note - Students who graduate from a program in the reporting year (Summer 2024-Spring 2025) who graduate from a program and enroll in an additional program are counted for both programs. Students who graduate from more than one program in the reporting year are counted for all applicable programs. Students who only take summer quarter off (Summer 2025) and return the subsequent fall quarter (Fall 2025) are not counted as drops at the end of the Spring 2025 term.
